### **Re- Provincial roads in Ndlambe Ward 3**

Dear Sir,

We thank you for your reply with regard to various road issues in Ward 3, Ndlambe Municipal area.

The issue of safety on the R72 over the Bushman's River remains of great concern. We have two other possible suggestions and they are the following:-

- 1) There are passing zones marked on the road going down the western side which should rather be double barrier lines. This would stop some of the dangerous situations which arise in this area on a daily basis.
- 2) Would it not be possible to make traffic circles at both the Kenton and Bushman's intersections on the R72? What we are suggesting is similar to the traffic circles on the N2 at Plettenberg Bay.

The main problem is, and we are sure you are aware of the situation, that the R72 has become a main trucking route and is not N status. There is evidence of this in the road breaking up badly in the area between Fonteinskloof and Ncancha.
